HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines. This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

UETDRRF06B Perform rescue from a live LV panel

This Competency Standard Unit covers the performance of rescue procedures from live Low Voltage (LV) apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables in the workplace. It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

Are there physical requirements for this course?

A requirement of the training package is that you are to be assessed as **physically capable of performing uninterrupted CPR for at least 2 minutes on an adult CPR manikin placed on the floor**. There can be no exceptions to these Australian Government requirements that are clearly written into the Training Package. Therefore, students who are unable to satisfy the physical requirements of the course cannot be deemed competent or issued with a statement of attainment, even if the qualification is a necessary part of their employment conditions.

Course duration:

- **Face to Face:** 3 hours face to face training
- **Mixed Mode:** Completion pre-course study **plus** 2 hours practical training
- **Refresher:** Completion pre-course study **plus** 2 hours practical training

Prerequisites: There are no prerequisites for this course.

Unique Student Identifier (USI)
